



FY20 COMMUNITY IMPACT GRANT PROCESS

July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020

The FY20 grant cycle for community impact grant funding supporting Greater Baytown Area and Chambers County is now open. Eligible applicants are nonprofit agencies providing human services. All applicants must be federally recognized as a 501 (C) 3 nonprofit organization.

November 9, 2018 5 pm	Submit a letter of intent (LOI) to apply online by November 9, 2018 by 5pm. LOIs received after that time will not be accepted. All LOIs must be submitted electronically.
November 16, 2018	Agency contact will be notified if they meet funding criteria and priorities and will be invited to submit a full application
November 16, 2018	Request for Proposal (RFP) available for successful LOI applicants.
