HISTORY

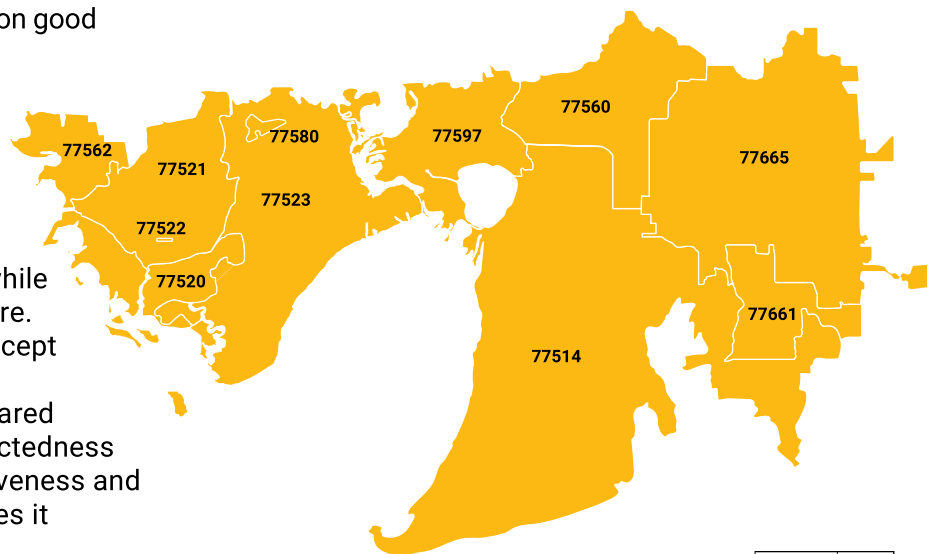
