

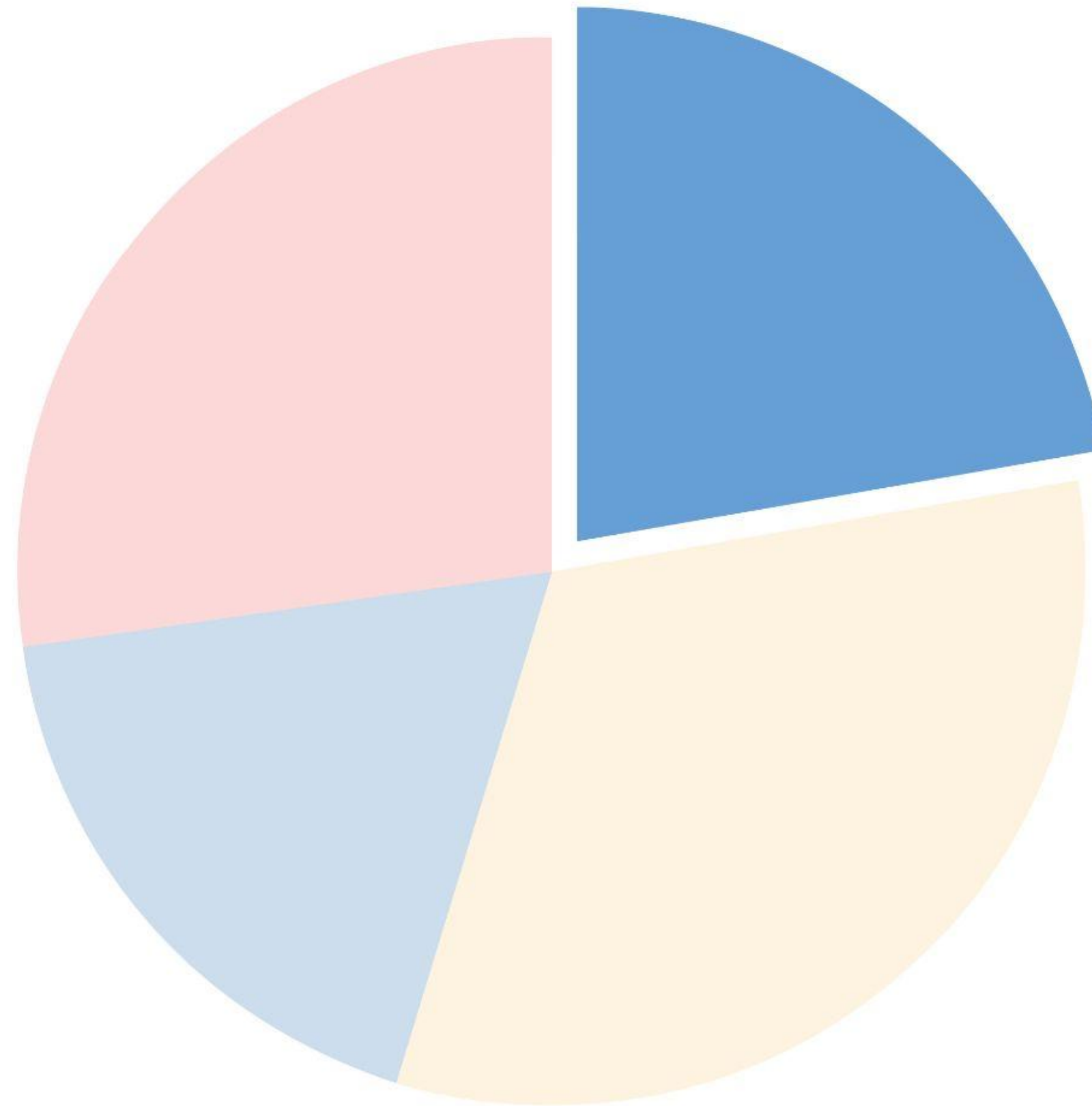

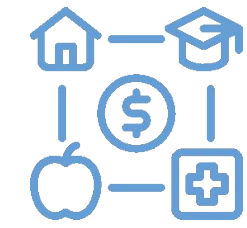

Overall Investment

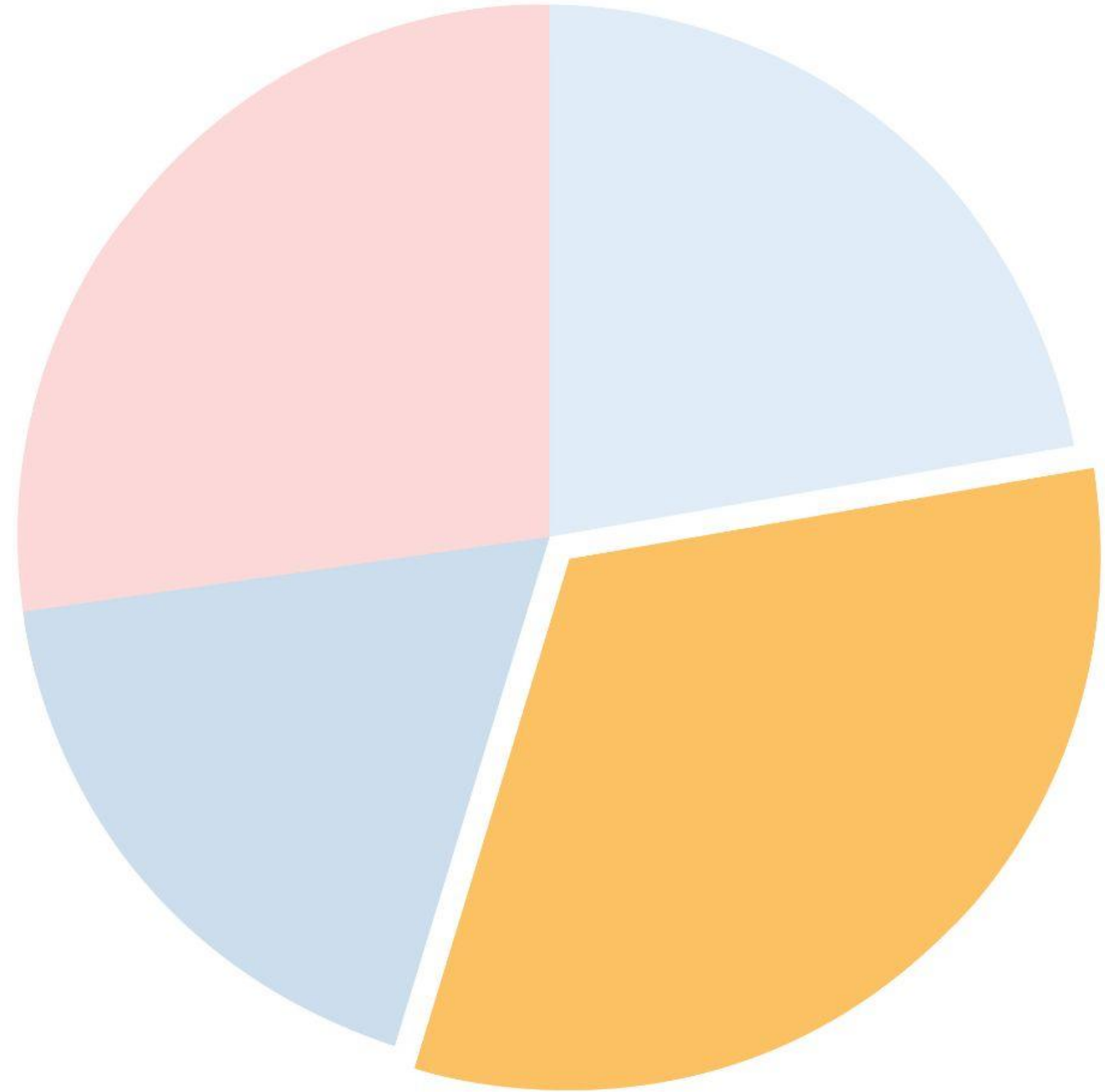
